相聲的前世今生一以「相聲與戲劇」的關聯為主

摘要

研究相聲發現一個有趣、也很重要的現象,就是相聲與戲劇有著前世今生糾結 的關聯,「相聲」這門藝術雖然誕生於清代,至今才一百多年,但它絕非從天而降, 追其淵源,吸取了唐代「參軍戲」及明代「隔壁戲」的養分;傳統相聲的演員爲什 麼經常以古典戲劇(戲曲)爲素材,既能唱又能演?京劇中的丑角對話,爲什麼看 起來和相聲有類似的語言諧趣?現代的「相聲劇」、「小品」,運用了大量戲劇表 演元素,到底是相聲?還是戲劇?本文視相聲爲一有機體,將之擬人化,從戲劇觀 點切入,除了追溯相聲在成型前一一「前世」的戲曲元素,並分析相聲「今生」發 展中的戲曲素材,以及向戲曲靠攏的表演形式,更從「相聲」與「戲曲」兩者相互 影響的關聯中,剖析相聲藝術,對相聲作一現象分析,除了對相聲的「前世」作深 入探源之外,更期望相聲的今生、來世都活得精采。

The Previous and Present life of Xiangsheng: A Disussion Mainly about the Relationship between Xiangsheng and Drama

Abstract

Research into *Xiangsheng* shows that it is closely connected to traditional Chinese drama in many ways. Though the performing art form of *Xiangsheng* only dates back to the Qing dynasty, around a hundred or more years ago, its origin can be traced back to the Canjunxi in the Tang dynasty and the Gebixi in the Ming dynasty. Traditional Xiangsheng patter borrows a lot from classical drama (traditional Chinese drama) in forms and skills. Xiangsheng artists have to not only talk, but also sing and act. In addition, Xiangsheng performers speak in a way very similar to the role type chou (the clown) in Beijing Opera. What's more, in modern "Xiangsheng plays" and "skits", lots of traditional theatrical elements are involved, making it difficult to tell which category these works should fall into, Xiangsheng or drama. In this essay, Xiangsheng is regarded as a living organism that evolves. By looking for the theatrical elements in *Xiangsheng*, the thesis intends to find out *Xiangsheng*'s similarities to traditional Chinese drama in its "previous life", that is, in the past, and also discuss the inspiration traditional Chinese drama works have offered Xiangsheng these days (in its "present life"). Through the study of the interrelationship between the two, the thesis aims to bring about a deeper understanding of *Xiangsheng* and prepares it for a richer and fuller life in the future.
